On 5/2/2007, I was working an extra duty job with a surveying crew due to threats they had received the prior day from a man stating that he was not afraid to take the law into his own hands. My shift started at 0800 hours and was to end at 1800 hours.

During our time on Fleeman Road Nellie Sue Worley approached the crew and I several times. Ms. Worley repeatedly was told to leave and she proceeded to act disorderly and repeatedly returned.

Ms. Worley was arrested and charged with Disorderly Conduct. Deputy Walker transported Ms. Worley to the Barrow County Detention Center.

On 5/2/2007, I was working an extra duty job with a surveying crew due to threats they had received the prior day from a man stating that he was not afraid to take the law into his own hands. My shift started at 0800 hours and was to end at 1800 hours.

Upon my arrival, I met with the crew who stated that they would be surveying Fleeman Road and part of Dee Kennedy Road. When the crew set up within a half an hour of our arrival a female later identified as Nellie Sue Worley stopped very suddenly and pulled partially out of the roadway onto the grass on the opposite side of the roadway from my patrol car. I exited my vehicle and we met each other in the middle of the roadway. Ms. Worley was visibly shaking and appeared extremely angry. Ms. Worley began yelling at me and wanted to know why I was out there. I attempted to explain to Ms. Worley that I was there for the surveyor's protection. Ms. Worley asked me why I was there for they're protection because she had not threatened anyone. As I tried to explain to Ms. Worley that a man had made the threats and I was just there as a precaution she again began yelling stating that having me here was humiliating and embarrassing to her and her reputation and that she had not threatened anyone. I apologized to Ms. Worley that she felt embarrassed and humiliated by my presence but I was out there to protect the survey crew.

I was trying to calm Ms. Worley and explain that my presence did not reflect on her or her reputation but was not successful in calming her down. Ms. Worley stated that she knows Joe referring to Sheriff Joel Robinson and is very good friends with him. Ms. Worley stated that she was going to go speak with "Joe" because she had another situation she needed to speak with him about also, but stated that she was not going to tell me about the other situation. I advised Ms. Worley that the surveyor's were only doing their job and that she needed to leave. She again began stating that my presence was a humiliation and an embarrassment to her family. I again stated that she needed to go back to her residence or where ever she was headed before she

stopped.

Ms. Worley did not leave and then began making reference to the other situation stating that Deputies were all around her residence one night and no one had called to let her know. Ms. Worley stated she had been scared for her life because she believed they were going to break in her door and kill her. I asked Ms. Worley if she was speaking of Deputies killing her and she stated yes. I asked Ms. Worley if they were chasing someone and she stated no. Ms. Worley refused to tell me any further information on the other incident. Ms. Worley again stated that she would be speaking to Joe and I advised her that he should be in his office today. Ms. Worley continued to yell that she had not threatened anyone and I had no business out there humiliating her as she walked back to her vehicle. Ms. Worley then pulled off and appa

I observed Ms. Worley pull into her driveway, park, and get out of her vehicle. I lost sight of her after she had exited her vehicle. I spoke to "Buster"(Charles Dowdy), one of the crew members who was standing nearby and observed another crew member, Wil Hilliard, a good distance away in Ms. Worley's pasture taking measurements. Within a few minutes of me losing sight of Ms. Worley, I observed an older model blue pickup truck speeding through the pasture at a very high rate of speed. I recognized Ms. Worley as the driver of the pick up truck. Ms. Worley was driving straight for Wil when the crew chief, Tommy Burnham, radioed Wil and advised him to leave the pasture. Wil was able to exit the pasture before Ms. Worley was able to make it to his location. It appeared Ms. Worley was attempting to scare Wil out of her pasture. Ms. Worley jerked the truck hard to the left as she neared the woods and spun gravel as she turned. I started walking toward the pasture to make sure Wil had not been harmed when Ms. Worley parked the truck and started sweeping the bed of the truck. I later learned that Tommy had notified Wil to leave the pasture as Ms. Worley was quickly approaching.

Wil and Tommy left the area and drove back to the location where the third crewmember and I were. The crew moved their equipment further down the roadway, which happened to be directly in front of Ms. Worley's residence. I parked my patrol vehicle behind the crew 's truck on the opposite side of the roadway from Ms. Worley's residence.

As the crewmembers began setting out the equipment on the right of way, I noticed the blue truck racing toward the residence. Ms. Worley pulled into the front yard of her residence again at a very high rate of speed almost striking her fence and one of her dogs, which was not tied up. Ms. Worley parked the truck.

While on patrol, Deputy Walker arrived on scene to speak to me and I advised him of the previous incidents with Ms. Worley and asked for Lt. Farlow's cell phone number so I could call to inform him of the situation. I called Lt. Farlow from Deputy Walker's cell phone and told him of the incidents, which had already occurred, and how I was sure there were to be more incidents with the landowners. Lt. Farlow stated he would arrive on scene shortly.

As I was speaking with Deputy Walker, I saw Ms. Worley walking toward me I met Ms. Worley in the roadway. Ms. Worley still seemed very hostile and stated "what am I suppose to do with the dead cat in my yard" She then pointed toward a cat that had apparently been struck by a car and had landed on the right of way in front of Ms. Worley's property. I advised Ms. Worley she could notify animal control and they would come and pick the cat up. Ms. Worley then turned around and walked back into her front yard.

I finished speaking with Deputy Walker and he left the area. Byron Freeman, Survey Coordinator, arrived on scene and handed me a Survey and Inspection Permit, which had been signed by Wendell Fleeman. He explained to me that Mr. Fleeman had been the person who had made the threatening statements to them and believed he would start trouble. I asked Byron if he had, Ms. Worley's permit and he handed me a permit which had verbal Approval written on it but stated he believed he has another copy that had her signature on it. Byron asked me if I could return the next day to escort them while they finished the job in the area. I advised him he could speak with Lt. Farlow about making the arrangements but I would be able to if assigned the extra duty.

Lt. Farlow arrived on scene, as I was explaining the events that had taken place a burgundy Chevrolet Camero pulled up beside his vehicle, and an older female began questioning him as to what we were doing there. Lt. Farlow spoke to the driver and she then drove away. Lt. Farlow exited his vehicle and began speaking with Tommy and Byron. Lt. Farlow advised them if for any reason they were to be separated from me and felt they needed help to call 911. Lt. Farlow also explained to all of us that the shift supervisor (Lt. Pace), Capt. Scott, and Major Kogod had been briefed of the situation. Byron advised Lt. Farlow that they would like me to return the following day and he agreed. Lt. Farlow advised me to sit with all my emergency lights on while I was out with the crew and advise anyone else who stops that I am with the crew to make sure no one hits them while they are working. I turned on my emergency lights as Lt. Farlow left the scene. The crew finished working in that location and moved a short distance down the roadway. I observed Ms. Worley get into her vehicle and drive away from her residence. I had no

Later in the afternoon just after we had returned from lunch the crew set up their equipment on Fleeman Road close to Dee Kennedy Road. I parked behind the crew with my emergency lights activated. Tommy and Wil had driven to the second location approximately 150 ft to 200ft from our location where they were parked partially off the roadway with their vehicle facing on coming traffic. Tommy and Wil were at the rear of the truck unloading equipment from the back of the truck. Buster noticed Ms. Worley pull beside Tommy's truck and stop. Buster stated that maybe I should go make sure they are okay.

As I pulled up to where the truck was located, I observed Ms. Worley's vehicle stopped in the roadway with her vehicle door open. Ms. Worley was at the rear of the truck standing very close to Tommy. When Ms. Worley saw me, she stepped back and stated that she was going to be with us all day. I stated, "No, Maam you won't" she stated, "Why not it's my land." I again stated "No, Maam." Ms. Worley the yelled "We'll see about that, we'll just see about that." I radioed Lt. Pace and asked him to meet me at my location. Ms. Worley then got back into her vehicle and slammed the door. Ms. Worley sped off toward Dee Kennedy Road. Ms. Worley had turned around in a driveway and was head back towards our location. As Ms. Worley she passed the crew and I, she was speeding and as she was extremely close to us while we were standing in the lane we were stopped in. Ms. Worley then pulled back into her driveway. I asked Tommy what she had said to him and he stated that she asked them which one of them had told me that she had threatened them. Tommy said that he told her that no one had said that she threatened them. Tommy told me that he thought she was going to "jump on" him before I arrived.

Lt. Pace called my cell phone and I advised him of what had just occurred. I advised Lt. Pace that I would arrest Ms. Worley if she approached the crewmembers again. Lt. Pace stated he would send someone out to handle it. I informed Lt. Pace that I would call Lt. Farlow and update him on the situation. Lt. Pace told me that he was with Lt. Farlow and would inform him.

A short time later Deputy Walker arrived on scene and upon speaking with him

he advised me that Lt. Pace had instructed him to place Ms. Worley under arrest for Disorderly Conduct. I followed Deputy Walker to 974 Fleeman Road, Ms. Worley's residence. Deputy Walker and I approached the front door where Ms. Worley met us. Deputy Walker asked Ms. Worley to step outside so we could talk to her and she advised that she would sit on the front porch swing. Deputy Walker stated that he would like her to turn around and place her hands behind her back. Ms. Worley began yelling and refused to place her hands behind her back. Deputy Walker took hold of her right hand to place her in handcuffs and she started to resist. I took hold of her left wrist and she began pulling away from me in an attempt to free her hand. Deputy Walker instructed her to stop resisting and she stated that she was not resisting. Deputy Walker was finally able to place Ms. Worley in handcuffs after he continually instructed her to stop resisting. Deputy Walker checked for proper fit and double locked the handcuffs.

Ms. Worley asked Deputy Walker if she could lock her front door and get her keys. Deputy Walker advised her she could. We followed Ms. Worley inside her residence where she retrieved her keys. Ms. Worley refused Deputy Walker's assistance in locking her front door and proceeded to lock it herself. At one point, Ms. Worley started staring at me, called me sister, and made a comment referring to me ruining her reputation. I did not respond to Ms. Worley. I did not speak to Ms. Worley the entire time Deputy Walker and I were at her residence until Deputy Walker asked me to search her before he placed her in the back of his patrol vehicle. I asked Ms. Worley to stand near the back of the patrol vehicle and I asked her if the keys were the only item in her pockets to which she answered that she thought she had a pencil in her pocket and then stated that it was only her keys. Deputy Walker placed her into the rear of his patrol vehicle and transported her to the Barrow County Detention Center. I returned to the surveying crew's location and finished the extra duty assignment.

I have included a statement from all witnesses and a copy of the survey permit for Ms. Worley's property with this report. All encounters with Ms. Worley happened in the roadway or on the right of way. Ms. Worley was advised by Deputies when she bonded out that the survey crew and I would be on Fleeman Road the next day and for her not to have any contact with us or face further charges.
